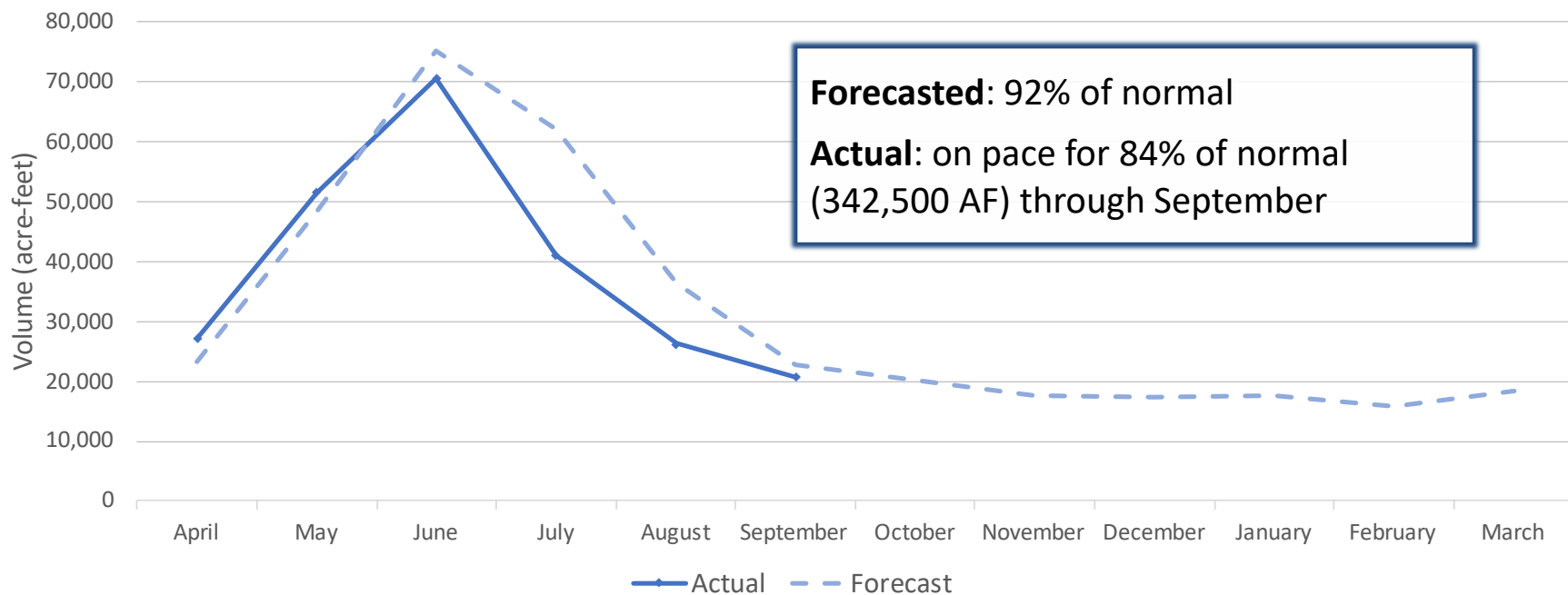
Purpose of the LTWA

The 1991 Long Term Water Agreement (LTWA) is the primary regulatory document that guides LADWP water resources management in the Owens Valley.

(LTWA III.A): *“The overall goal of managing the water resources within Inyo County is to **avoid** certain described decreases and changes in vegetation and **to cause no significant** effect on the environment which cannot be acceptably mitigated while **providing a reliable** supply of water for export to Los Angeles and for use in Inyo County”*

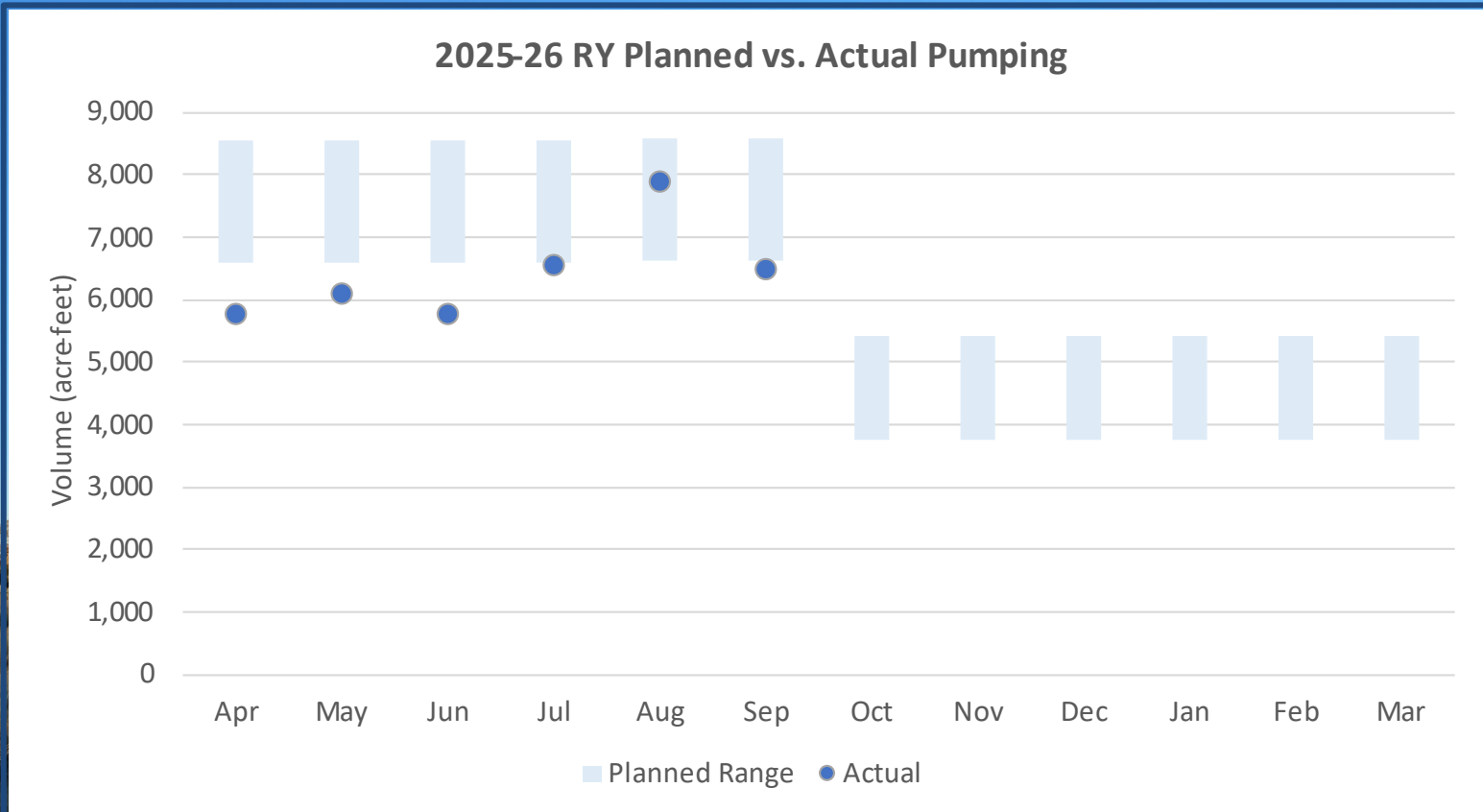
2025-26 Forecasted and Actual Owens Valley Runoff

Owens Valley River Basin Monthly Runoff



Pre-snowmelt peak actual runoff was **similar to** forecast.
Post-snowmelt peak actual runoff was **less than** forecast.

Monthly Planned and Actual Owens Valley Pumping



Planned Annual Pumping: 62,160 – 83,760 AF
Actual Pumping (through September): 38,500 AF
